

MESSAGE FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT: D2/D157 CURRICULUM DIRECTOR ANNOUNCEMENT

I wish to inform you that recently the Boards of Education approved the creation of a “shared” Curriculum Director position. This action resulted from recommendations provided by the Reorganization Study consultants, administrative recommendations, Shared Services Committee considerations, and Board deliberations.

At this time, I am pleased to announce the appointment of Belinda Veillon as the “shared” Curriculum Director between Nippersink School District 2 and Richmond-Burton High School District 157. Mrs. Veillon has been employed with the elementary district for twenty years administering gifted programs, supervising inclusion activities, assisting with curriculum and instruction development and implementation, and facilitating school improvement processes. Her qualifications, training, and experiences are a great fit to the responsibilities required of this position. The position she is vacating will not be replaced, as she will remain with some duties of her prior assignment, in addition to some tasks being shifted to other individuals.

Mrs. Veillon’s bachelor’s and school administrative degrees were completed at Louisiana State University. Doctoral coursework in curriculum & instruction has been completed at Loyola University.
